From Your Florida State Aerie Secretary

Dear Brothers and Sister Eagles

The FDPR Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation on June 26, 2020 issued an Emergency Order to Stop Serving and Drinking of Alcohol at Bars, in the State of Florida. The FOE Aerie's in Florida has to stop serving and drinking alcohol immediately because our Liquor Licenses are under the FDPR. Your Aerie can hold meetings as long as you comply with the **Guidelines set by the CDC** to help prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. We are not sure how long this **FDPR Emergency Order** will be in place, be safe and keep your members safe.

There will be a **Aerie Secretary School Saturday August 8, 2020**, if the CDC will allow us to hold the class. **The Class will be in Orlando Aerie 3496 and the time will be from 8:30 am to 4 pm. The Cost of the Class is \$25 a person, Orlando will provide a Lunch for a \$5 Donation. Anyone may attend the Class.** I will be sending out information to all the Aeries. **All the new secretaries should plan to attend this Class.** Please let me know if you will be attending the class in August because it may be limited to the amount of people we can have. I will also be setting up a Secretary Class sometime in October in Cape Coral if the CDC will allow us to have a class. Dates will be announced next month.

Aerie Secretaries make sure to Add the Aerie Officers and Committee members to the MMS.

The Florida State Aerie will be starting the Grand Aerie Surveys for all the Aerie's in Florida when the Aerie's will be able to reopen.

If you are going to be turning in any Grants the Children's Fund, Cancer Fund, Alzheimer's Fund and the Parkinson's Fund is out of money for this year.
